Plant of the Month

Buddleja davidii "Dark Knight" Butterfly Bush

The fragrant arching clusters are irresistible to birds and butterflies. Really a shrub, plants are best treated like perennials and pruned



back hard each spring to maintain a compact, bushy habit. This selection has long wands of dark purple

flowers, on a tall clump. Excellent for cutting. Remove faded flower heads to continue flowering. Drought and heat tolerant once established.

Tuesday 1 August 2017 7.45pm Lecture Theatre, Goodman Building, Hackney Rd Speaker Bob Major, Volcanic eruption of Mt St Helens.

Due to the eruptions of 1980-86

and 2004-2008, Mount St. Helens has had the best seismic monitoring



network of all volcanoes in the Cascade Range. It is also the most seismically active volcano in the Washington and Oregon Cascades. In an average month, 22 events are located by the Pacific Northwest Seismic Network (PNSN), with the number going far higher during eruptive periods. The first complete network of stations was installed in 1980 in response to unrest starting in March of that year. Since then millions of earthquakes, as well as other non-earthquake signals (e.g., rockfalls, explosions, avalanches, glacier guakes, helicopters) have been recorded. Seismic data recorded by this network have been used in many studies.
